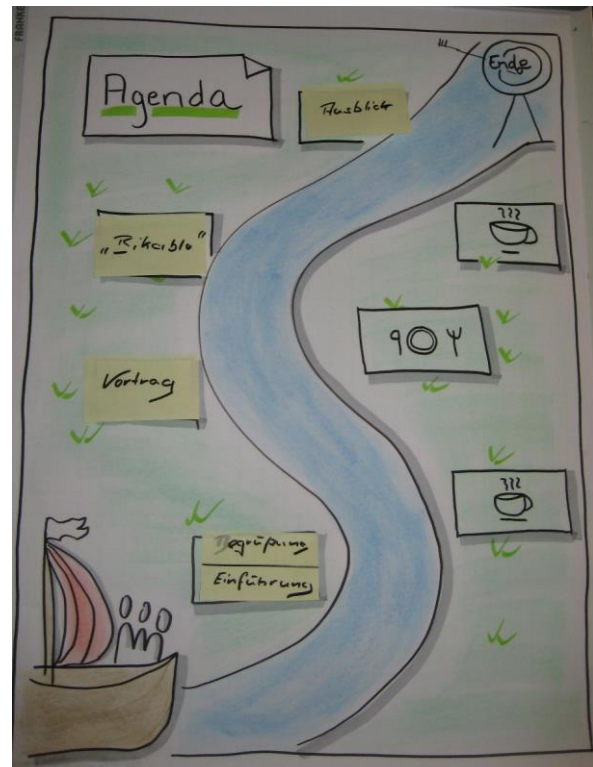


The project objective is improving vocational training; apprentices are to be enabled during vocational training to acquire the competences, which allow them an enduringly successful participation in a globalized world of work.
